It is with great regret that Miss Zuzarte will be resigning as Class 1 teacher at the end of this term, on Friday 12th February. She will be moving with her family to Nottingham due to her husband's work and will be looking for a new teaching job there. We will all miss her dearly, but I know that we'll stay in touch. We wish her all the very best in whatever she does. Thank you for everything Miss Zuzarte.

We are very lucky however, and I am pleased to inform that Mrs Thompson and Miss O'Callaghan will be replacing Miss Zarte as our Class 1 teachers. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact me.

Coronavirus Safety:

As part of our continued efforts to keep the school as safe as possible, we have organised for our classrooms, offices and corridors to be sprayed with an antimicrobial surface coating. This coating has been scientifically proven to eliminate Coronavirus as well as a range of bacteria and enveloped viruses for recommended periods up to 90 days. Our first treatment will be completed before half-term, followed by subsequent treatments each quarter, with monitoring visits taking place at the midway point between treatments. This is similar to the approach now used by some supermarkets, factories and public transport. The spraying will take place when the school is closed to students and staff, and once bonded to surfaces, the water based coating is classified as non-irritant.
