Class 2:

This term Class 1's Topic is 'Shipwrecked'. We will be learning all about the pirate Blackbeard and the explorer Sir Francis Drake. We will be Angel Pott creating our own 'modern day' pirate maps using computers and tracking Blackbeard's and Drake's journeys. We build on our knowledge of **Rylee She** the continents and oceans and we will be having a class visit to Skegness Aquarium. (Letter to follow shortly). In maths we will be building on **Brodie Ca** our number and place value skills and focusing on sentence structure in English.

Class 2:

The children have all settled quickly back to school, with Year 3 in particular settling well into Class 2. Our topics this term include the Human Body in Science, Ancient Egypt in History, Coding in ICT and Photographs in Art. Our Big Question in RE is 'How do Christians express their beliefs?' In English we will be looking at a mixture of stories, information texts and persuasive writing, practising a variety of literacy skills through these genres. We have already made a good start with our first maths focus on place value and will continue to learn a variety of maths skills and how to apply them as the term goes on.


