Report - Children's Wellbeing in a Digital World - 2022...

Internet Matters in partnership with University of Leicester and Revealing Reality have released a new report in relation to digital technology and wellbeing which shows 'striking differences between children of different ages, genders and demographic backgrounds. There are some interesting key findings...

- While displaying some positive impacts, greater social media use, especially among girls, was associated with increased negative impacts on wellbeing.
- Vulnerable children experience more of the negative impacts of digital technology on wellbeing than their less vulnerable peers. You can read the full report HERE.

Instagram Accounts being Hijacked...

A concerning new tactic is to send a message to an Instagram user stating that a recent posted photo contains copyright material. Nevan Lawrence In order to appeal, you have to click a link in the message, input your username/password and appeal the copyright claim. At each stage, the message and design is very much Instagram. This as a phishing scam. Once the offender has the user credentials they hijack the account and demand money.
