Already we are into the second half of the academic year! We have plenty to be looking forward to this term...

Class 1:

This term in Class 1 our Topic is Elizabeth I. We will be learning about her life, her coronation, the explorers of her time and the Armada. In Maths we will be looking at symmetry and pattern in shape and continuing with the White Rose small steps.

We will be continuing to follow the RWI programme for our Phonics & Literacy. In DT we are designing and making puppets for a zoo gift shop. For R.E this term, we will be looking at Islam and asking the question: What does the Qur'an say about how Muslims should treat others and live their lives?

Class 2:

Class 2 have lots of exciting new topics starting this term. Our learning in geography will be based around the continent of North America. In science we will be learning about the lifecycles of different plants and animals. Our RE topic focuses on the five pillars of Islam and what they mean for Muslims. In DT we will be investigating, designing and making our own kites. We have already begun a new music project: a crash course in learning to play the ukulele! As well as all this we will continue to build on a variety of skills during English and Maths, with a particular focus on fractions (and decimals and percentages for the older year groups).
